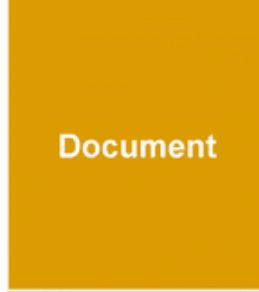

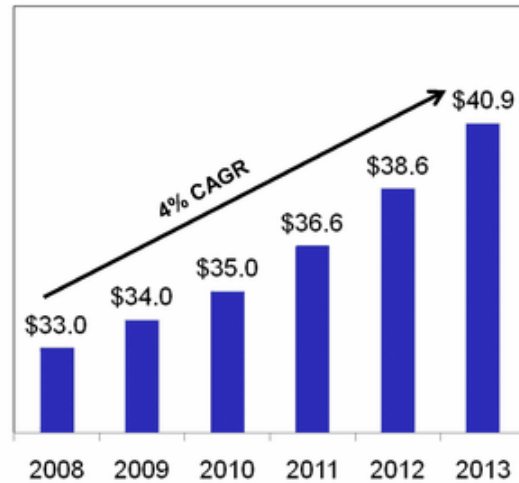

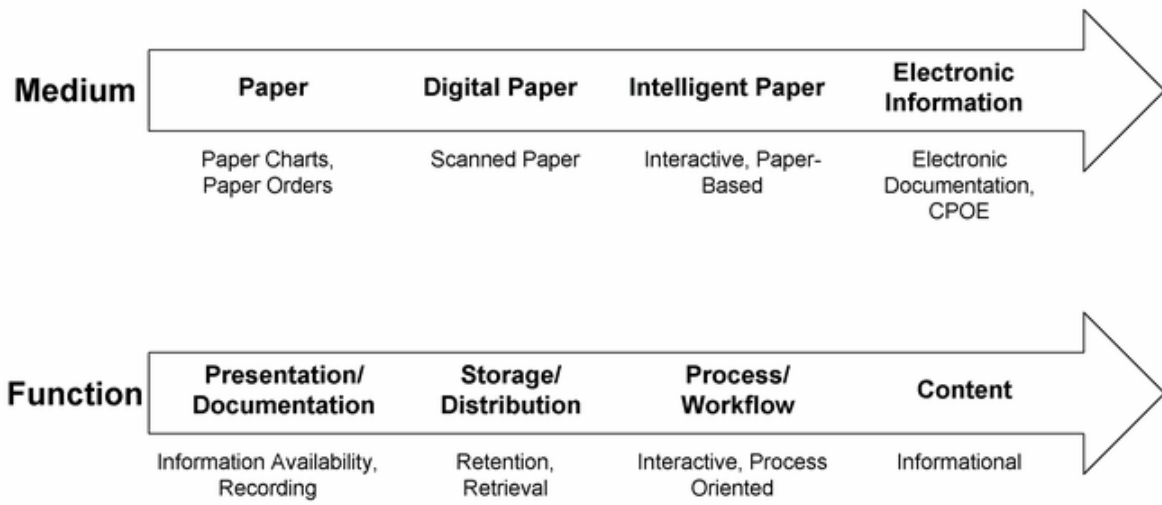

(\$ in billions)



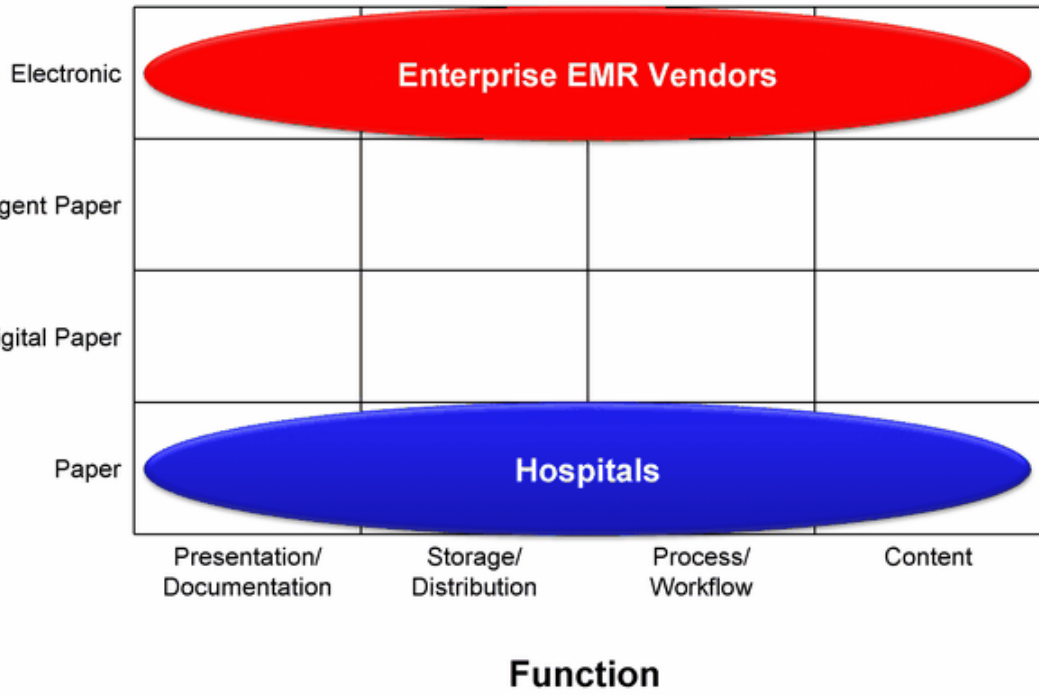

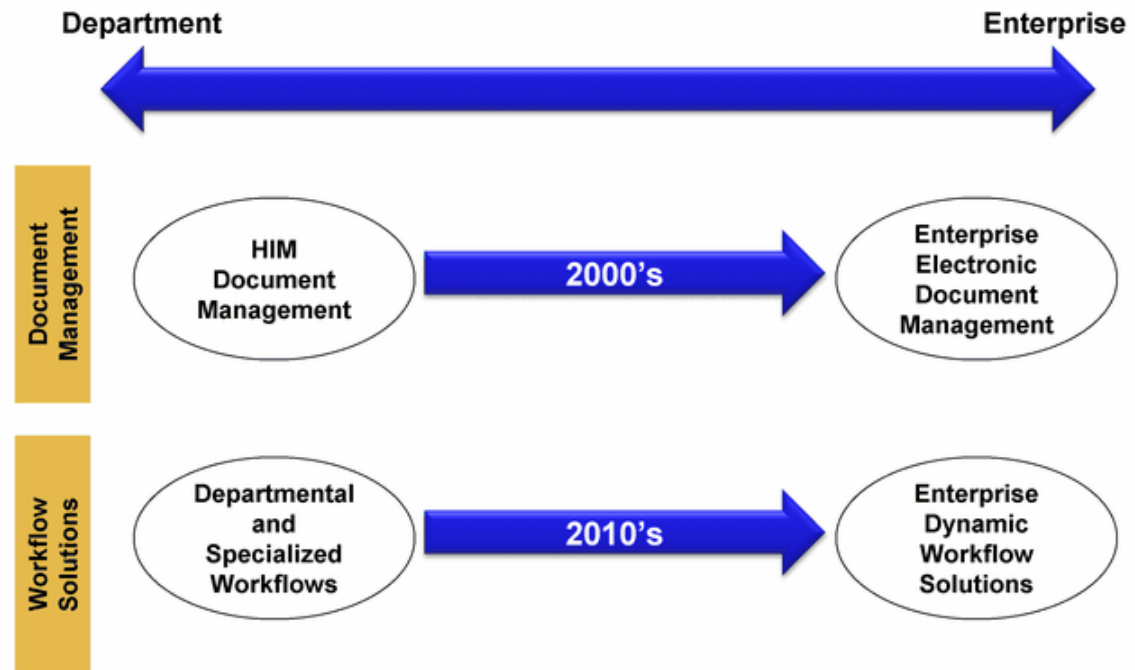

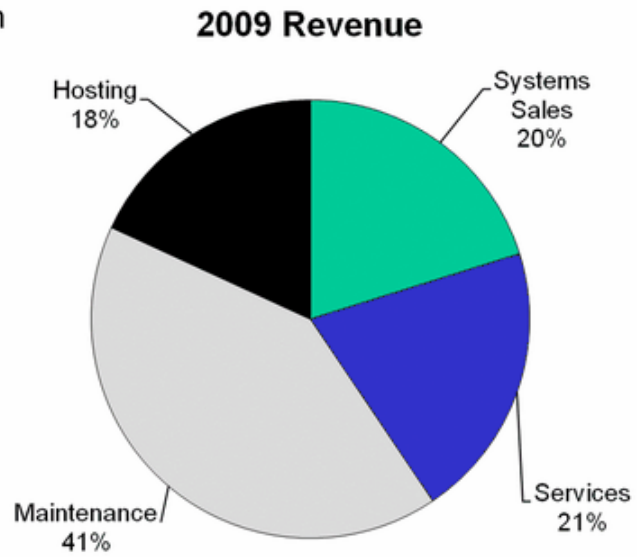

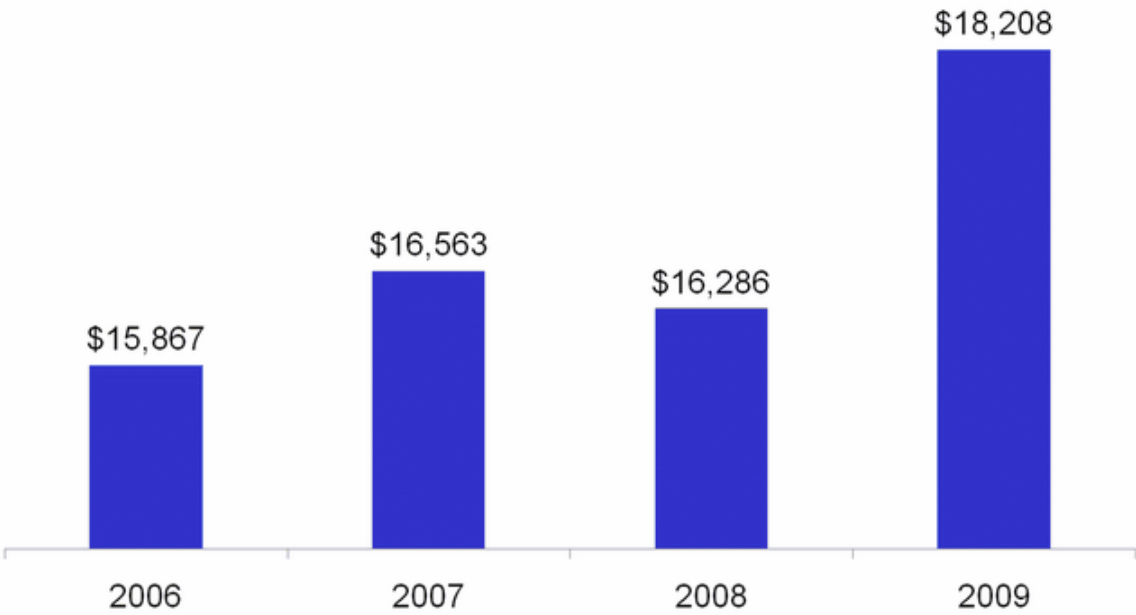

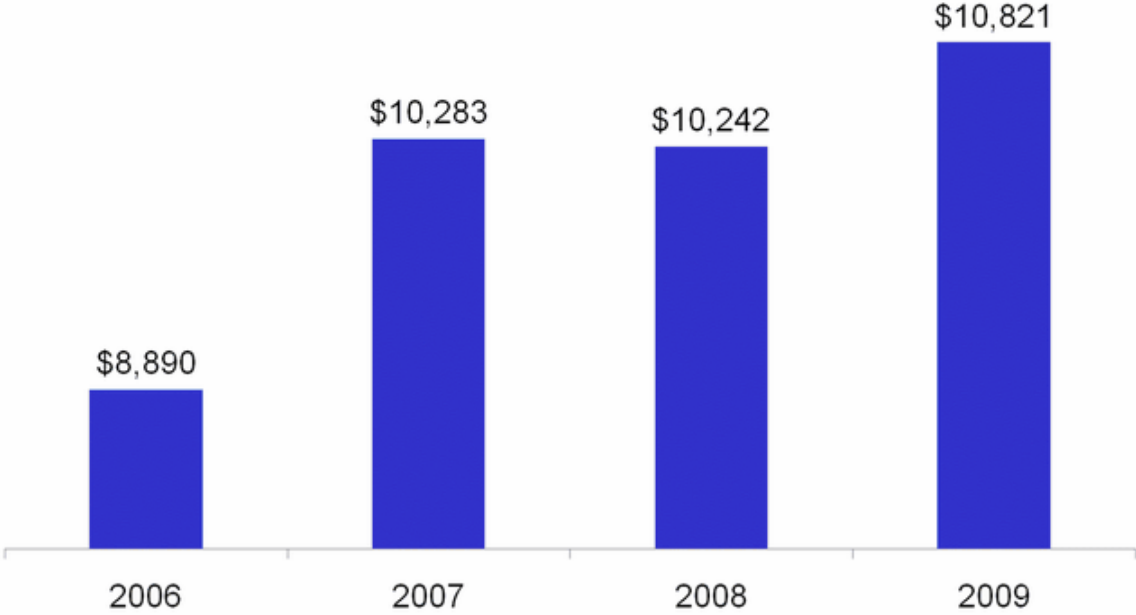

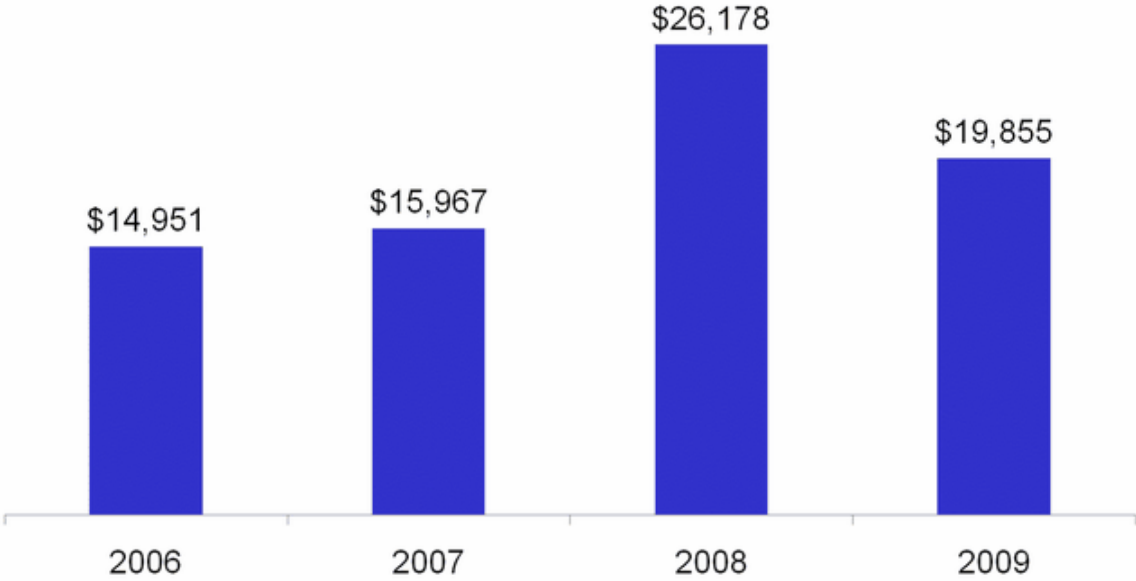
Revenue Inflection Point (\$ in thousands)



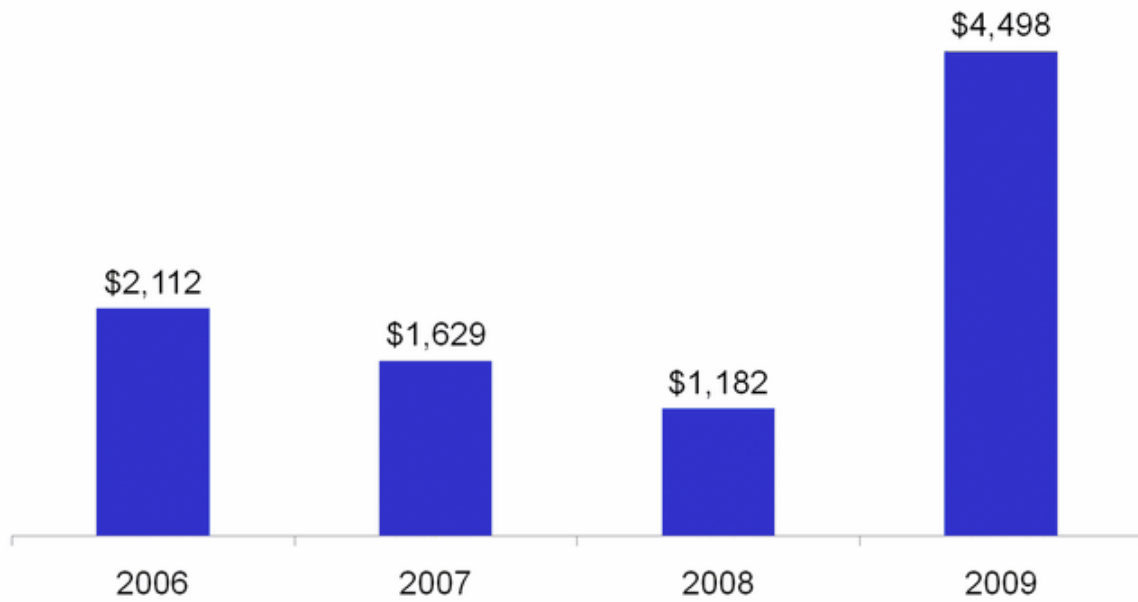
Growing Recurring Revenue (\$ in thousands)
